

Twipes cross the Atlantic with the Oars of Thunder rowing team

Oars of Thunder is the second Twipes-sponsored rowing team to cross the Atlantic as part of the "World's Toughest Row" competition for charity. The team is made up of four rowers who will cross from the Canary Islands to the island of Antigua to raise £100k for charity.

With a limited amount of fresh water to use aboard the boat, Twipes provide a sustainable option for staying fresh clean without having to expend any of the boat's supply of fresh water.

Because Twipes break down within three hours in water or seven days in landfill, our wet wipes help rowers and other outdoor explorers to leave no trace behind during their expeditions, no matter how extreme.

Lightweight and easy to carry

In addition to necessities like food and clothing, the Oars of Thunder team also needs to pack other items that are practical and necessary, as well as lightweight. Twipes come in an easy-to-carry pack with 80 wet wipes per unit.
